# 71.40 cont.

(c)(4)(iii) Clinical ratings will be scored as follows:

**Zero** – If veteran completes the task without assistance.

One – If veteran can complete 75% of the task without supervision or assistance.

**Two** – If veteran can complete 50 to 74% of the task without assistance.

**Three** – If veteran can complete 25 to 49% of the task without assistance.

Four – If the veteran can complete less than 25% of the task without assistance.

# 71.40 cont.

(c)(4)(iv) If the sum of all the ratings is;

- (A) 21 or higher the veteran is assumed to require 40 hours per week of caregivers assistance.
- (B) 13 to 20 the veteran is assumed to require 25 hours per week of assistance.
- (C) 1 to 12 the veteran is assumed to require 10 hours per week of assistance.
